## HOW TO PLAN FOR YOUR SHIRT FINISHING SYSTEM

Your priority is to select a shirt production system to meet your present needs and for your projected growth. Selecting between a Single Buck and a Double Buck Shirt System is based on your projected growth and the number of shirts each unit will produce in an hour or a day.

The next decision is to determine if a Two-Piece Unit or Three-Piece Unit will best fit your production requirements. Both styles of Shirt Finishing Systems will produce the same number of shirts in the same length of time. The basic difference is the type of finish on the shirt sleeves. The Three-Piece System finishes the sleeves with a firm pressing finish, and the Two-Piece System offers a softer, air-blown finish. Both finishes are widely accepted by all customers.

Your decision may also be made based on your floor space. The Three-Piece System requires a slightly larger footprint.

After selecting and purchasing the style of Shirt Finishing System for your store, the most important priority is your customer. Your customer wants a quality finish, and you should make a fair profit on each shirt.
